Eye on America: a daily 60-minute program on U.S. news and other developments. It airs in the morning local time.

Issues & Opinions: a 60-minute news and talk program on major development in China.

Pro & Con: a weekly hour-long talk show debating controversial issues in the news.

Strait Talk: a weekly hour-long call-in show co-produced with Broadcasting Corporation of Taiwan. Callers from China and Taiwan meet on-air to discuss news and issues of common interest.

Cultural Odyssey: a weekly 20-minute TV magazine on American life and entertainment.

Walk into America: a bi-weekly television feature on American culture, life and people.

History's Mysteries: an occasional hour-long TV documentary program focusing on untold stories, suppressed memories and distorted narratives in China's recent past.

Sports English: as the title suggests, this segment teaches phrases and expressions used in sports.
