VOA News Today (3 hours/daily): VOA Korean's main news show provides comprehensive news coverage on North Korea from Washington and Seoul. It includes live 5-minute newscasts at the top of every hour with the latest news headlines from around the world.

Early Morning (1 hour/Monday-Friday): The program covers major developments around the Korean peninsula and discusses the U.S. reaction to them.

Live from Washington (2 hours/daily): This current affairs show includes the latest news, as well as entertainment developments in the U.S. and around the world.

Washington News Parade (1 hour/daily): This daily news program offers original reporting and in-depth coverage on North Korea.

Washington Talk (20 minutes/weekly): A Washington-based discussion series reviewing the week's top events affecting North Korea, from the perspective of the United States, featuring VOA journalists and top experts (satellite/Korean Service website/YouTube/Facebook).

Global Report (5 minutes/twice a week): A feature program on science, technology, education, agriculture, and business (Korean Service website/YouTube/Facebook).

Speak Easy English (2 minutes/three times a week): VOA's English learning content contributes to sophisticated understanding of American English (Korean Service website/YouTube/Facebook).

Flushing People (20 minutes/bi-weekly): A documentary series that provides a colorful examination of one of America's largest Korean communities in Flushing, New York.
