Combined with comprehensive coverage of major news events, enlightening investigations, detailed fact checking, balanced analysis and extensive beat coverage, the output of VOA's News Center results in a wide-ranging catalog of trustworthy journalism brought to global audiences estimated to exceed 275 million viewers, listeners and readers.

Programs

The VOA News Center provides 1 total hour of live TV broadcasts each week.

The Inside Story -- a 30-minute TV program exploring all aspects of U.S. policy through interviews with policy makers and opinion shapers.

VOA Connect – a 30-minute TV program that brings together stories of people across the U.S. and around the world, from a virtual reality brain surgeon to a Vietnam War vet connecting to the daughter he never knew.

The VOA News Center provides 20 hours of live radio and on-demand podcasts each week.

International Edition: A 25-minute news program airing on weekdays that delivers insight into world news through eye-witnesses, correspondent reports and analysis from experts and newsmakers.

Flashpoint Ukraine: A 25-minute podcast airing on weekdays that examines the most recent developments in the Russia-Ukraine war while also featuring stories from those affected by the conflict. Hosts speak with experts from around the world to deliver in-depth analysis.

Flashpoint Iran: A 25-minute weekly podcast that features news and analysis about the Islamic Republic's suppression of domestic dissent, sensitive nuclear activities, and involvement in regional and international conflicts. Host Michael Lipin speaks with newsmakers, researchers, activists and journalists who share insights about Iran's situation.

Issues in the News: A 25-minute weekly news program that focuses on the biggest stories of the week. The program's in-depth analysis provides the inside story on both domestic and international news.
